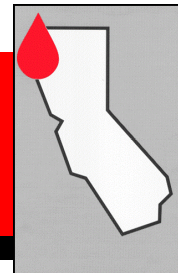

## The Self Registration Questionnaire is here!

If you have been in to donate in the last few months, you have definitely noticed some changes in the donation process. We at the Northern California Community Blood Bank are proud to say that we have unveiled the Self Registration Questionnaire (SRQ) at the main donor center and now on all three of our bloodmobiles. We are also proud to say that we are among the first blood centers to use this technology on the mobiles! Our goal is to continue to provide the safest blood products possible to patients in need, and with the SRQ system, we have added another layer of safety to the process.

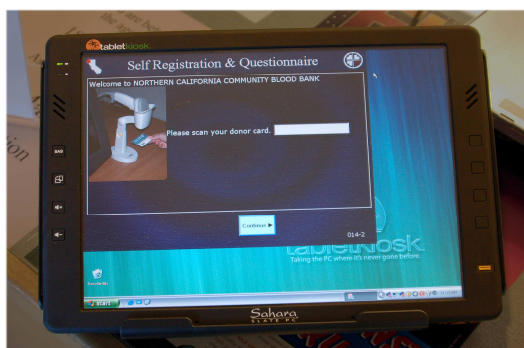
The SRQ tablets were part of our long awaited computer software upgrade which are helping us keep the blood supply safe in a variety of ways. The

only the questions that need attention, plus any follow-up questions that pertain to the original question. So, based on your responses, your time in the screening area can be reduced. This allows for a very thorough investigation of donor responses, and ensures that no information is missed, eliminating human error.



The elimination of the paper system has come with many challenges, but we're happy to say that we made it! ## Administrator's View

On March 16, 2009, yours truly became President of American's Blood Centers. (ABC) ABC was founded in 1962 and is North America's largest network of non-profit community blood centers. The position is elected by the members of ABC and I feel quite honored to have earned the trust of blood bankers across North America. I thought it would be interesting for readers of our newsletter to hear a little bit about ABC.

ABC's US members are regulated by the Food and Drug Administration and our Canadian member is regulated by Health Canada. ABC members serve more than 160 million people at 600 plus collection sites across 45 states and Canada. Blood products and related services are provided to 4,200 hospitals and healthcare facilities. 9.3 million units of whole blood are collected by our members which is over half of the US blood supply. More than 10 million blood components are provided to the hospitals served, including red blood cells, platelets and plasma products.

ABC members also provide the majority of tissue, bone marrow, stem cell and transfusion services and the largest source of blood donations are corporate blood drives. Schools, civic groups and the faith community are also major sponsors of blood donations in North America.

All ABC members share a community based blood banking philosophy. This means community donors know the blood they share is available to their community first and is there to help their families, friends, and neighbors. Blood in excess of the local need is shared with other communities who need it most. This is done contractually or on an ad hoc basis as needed to serve patients. We are all committed to helping each other.

ABC's biggest priority is blood safety and it works with federal agencies such as the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to assure there is an adequate and safe blood supply to meet the needs of thousands of patients daily. Other areas of focus are vigilance of the blood supply, resource sharing and working with FDA to help develop policies that balance blood safety with the need to maintain an adequate blood supply.

ABC blood centers are committed to provide safe and effective blood components and work hard to improve their procedures. They have quality programs and task forces designed to ensure compliance with all regulatory standards. ABC helps its members with benchmarking, quality training and information sharing. Since ABC members play a critical role in our nation's public health and military support infrastructures, emergency preparedness is a topic of increasing importance for society. There are threats of international terrorism, natural disasters and the risk of global pandemics. ABC is part of AABB's Interorganizational Task Force on Domestic Disasters and Acts of Terrorism and works with representatives of blood services organizations, governmental agencies and

## Blood Donations in the Schools

I would like to take an opportunity to thank all of the schools that held blood drives in 2008 and helped to make it such a great year! Most high school donors are first time donors who often become regular donors by their senior year. This helps us to meet our need for 3000 new donors a year to off-set the donors who become ineligible. This school year we started a new Honors Cord program at the high schools to encourage high school students to become lifetime donors. If a senior has donated 3 times or more by the end of the school year, they will be honored with a red cord at graduation. Our blood supply would be severely hindered without our high school drives which happen two or three times a year. In 2008 we had 1546 donors come to high school drives. A Big Thank You to the following schools; Arcata, Del Norte, Eureka, Ferndale, Fortuna, Hoopa, McKinleyville, South Fork, St.

Bernard, Zoe Barnum!!

I also want to thank our two local colleges, Humboldt State University and College of the Redwoods. They have held outstanding blood drives this year. HSU hosts drives on campus twice weekly, and without that constant blood supply we would be in great need. Humboldt State saw 907 donors in 2008, which is up over the last two years totals. We go to the College of the Redwoods 3 times a month and saw 422 donors in 2008, which is up from the last 2 years also.

These donations constitute nearly 9% of our blood supply. When combined with the high schools, over 18% of local donations are from young people in our schools

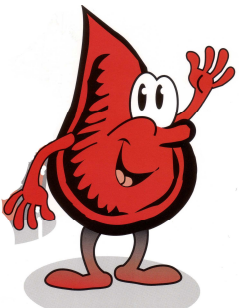
I would also like to thank all the teachers and student sponsors for all the hard work they put into these drives. I've enjoyed working with all of you and look forward to future drives.

commercial entities to plan for and respond to any event that could impact the nation's blood supply.

ABC members also work to protect the rights of donors, patients, hospitals and community blood centers. They help shape new laws, policies and standards of care through coalition memberships, grassroots advocacy and lobbying.

The latter groups work together internationally to try to make sure safe blood is available to all patients. ABC, EBA and ABO along with the Asian Pacific Blood Network are a global alliance with a remit to shape policy and good practices with an organizational and service delivery focus.

It will be a busy two year term including a great deal of travel as President of ABC and I still have my day job here at NCCBB. We have a great leadership team and staff at NCCBB and with their help, along with email, sim cards, text messaging and cell phones, NCCBB and I will survive the two year term and the blood center will keep on serving our local community.

As always, it continues to be a wonderful career working with the nicest folks in town who are helping save the lives of the patients we all serve.

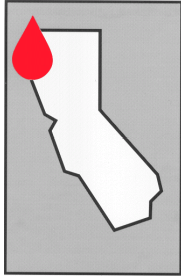
